Installation Instructions for LJ-3071 Toggle Bolt Mounting Kit

- 1. Mark the center of the newel on the floor or starting step. Drill a 1 1/2" hole through the floor system or tread.
- **2.** Measure the thickness of the plywood *and* finished floor system. Subtract this from the useable length of the toggle bolt. Use the remaining length of the bolt to mark the center of the 1 1/2" hole in the side of the newel post, which you are about to drill.
- **3.** Drill 1 1/2" hole in the side of the newel post (do not go clear through newel). Drill a 9/16" hole in the base of the newel until it intersects the 1 1/2" hole.
- **4.** Push the toggle bolt into the floor hole holding the end of the bolt. With a thin blade putty knife or something similar, keep the bolt from dropping to the floor cavity.
- **5.** Put the newel over the bolt and insert the washer and nut together with a wrench. Remove the putty knife.
- **6.** Apply glue to the inside of the hole and tap the plug into place leaving slightly above flush. Then sand flush.

Tools Needed: 9/16" Spade Bit, 1 1/2" Spade Bit, 3/4" Wrench.
